The Marion County Chamber of Commerce will be issuing three \$1000 cash scholarships in May of 2024 to two Marion County High School Seniors and one Marion County Area Technology Senior.

The Chamber of Commerce recognizes the need for cash flow and we, as a Chamber, want to provide the cash students need for incidentals and unexpected expenses that will help with a smooth transition to college life.

Eligibility Requirements

1. A senior at Marion County High School who will graduate in the spring of 2024.
2. Will attend full-time or part-time at an accredited college/university, junior college or trade school in the fall of 2024.
3. A resident of Marion County, Kentucky.
4. Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0. (Copy of **transcript required**)
5. Submit a personal essay (see below for content) not to exceed three pages, double-spaced and typed.
6. Two letters of recommendation from community members. The letters should address the applicant's community involvement.
7. Delivery of the completed application, essay and letters of recommendation to the offices listed above by April 8, 2024.

Procedures

Completed applications that meet the above criteria and are received or postmarked by the April 8, 2024 deadline will be reviewed by the scholarship committee of the Marion County Chamber of Commerce. Awarded students will be notified shortly thereafter. *(Use as many additional pages as needed to complete the application)*

Academic Achievement

Provide transcript, GPA, class ranking, and class schedule

Section II- Leadership

Work Experience
