

Marion County Chamber of Commerce

The duties of the contractor for the clean up of Ham Days will include the following:

1. The Contractor's cleanup duties shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following:
 - (a) Beginning at 7:00pm on Friday, September 26, 7:00am on Saturday, September 27, and 7:00 am on Sunday September 28, 2025, empty all garbage cans and trash barrels in the breakfast area frequently, take trash bags (bags furnished by the Chamber) to dumpsters.
 - (b) Between stage performances after the parade on Saturday, pick up trash, blow trash into the streets from all areas so that street sweeper can pick up as much as possible.
 - (c) Empty all garbage cans and trash barrels around the Marion County Cattleman's booth, take trash bags to dumpsters.
 - (d) Empty all garbage cans and trash barrels on M.L. King Ave, in the area by the 2nd food court.
2. Clean the following areas on a continuous basis:
 - (a) From Mulberry St. to M. L. King Ave., including all side streets, for a distance beginning with Harrison St. and ending at Depot St.
 - (b) Main Street from the Marion County Library to Ragetti's Restaurant.
 - (c) Proctor Knott Avenue from its intersection with M. L. King Ave. to its intersection with Mulberry St.
 - (d) Depot Street from its intersection with M. L. King Ave. to its intersection with Mulberry St.
 - (e) The entire Arts & Crafts/Kentucky Proud areas as designated by Chamber's festival layout diagram
 - (f) All of the Marketplace area as designated by the Chamber's festival layout diagram.
 - (g) Spalding Avenue from its intersection with M. L. King Ave. to its intersection with Mulberry Streets.
 - (h) M. L. King Ave. between Depot Street and Harrison Avenue.
 - (i) Downtown area following the Friday night concert.
 - (j) Downtown area following the Saturday night concert.
3. The Contractor shall complete clean up detail following Saturday's activities before 5:00am on Sunday morning and shall complete clean up duties following the Sunday activities before 6 pm on Sunday night.
4. The Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing enough workers, at his cost, to complete his duties in a timely and efficient manner.
5. The areas to be cleaned shall be inspected on Sunday evening by a representative of the Chamber or the City of Lebanon and that representative will, in his/her sole discretion, determine if the clean up job has been performed completely and the Contractor shall be paid for his services only upon determination by the representative of the Chamber or the City that the clean up job has been concluded satisfactorily.
6. That upon the satisfactory completion by the Contractor of his duties under this contract, the Chamber shall issue payment directly to the Contractor immediately after work is completed on Sunday.
7. The Contractor accepts these duties as an independent contractor and acknowledges ~~that no employee/employer relationship exists as a result of this contract.~~
